I am writing to you to share with you the petition which has been completed by the residents of Harworth & Bircotes in relation to a response regarding Anti Social Behaviour (ASB)

The issue of ASB within the Harworth & Bircotes Area has in recent times escalated, culminating in criminal damage of a CCTV column. There is little protection available to residents and to this end residents are calling for a consultation and the initiation of a Public Space Protection Order (PSPO), to assist in the reduction of ASB and reduce the impact of ASB in our Community, in particular the most vulnerable.

The aim of the petition is to trigger a consultation to be undertaken allowing our public spaces to be enjoyed without the perpetration of ASB on the general public, tackling persistent issues that harm our communities and to provide a safer community allowing residents to thrive and enjoy a healthier lifestyle.


We have completed both online and in person signatures and would request that once there has been ratification completed, these sheets be destroyed; to protect our residents identities.

We have gathered in a short period of time 508 signatures, which I believe you will agree shows a level of concern and a need to commence a conversation.

We believe that the consultation should allow people to share their level of unease, their continued reduction in tolerance and to highlight the behaviours they no longer wish to contend with. We as a community would wish to undertake this in partnership with your officers to effectively improve our lives and feelings of safety.

I look forward to your response and would be happy to extend an invitation to you or your team to hold a public meeting if you feel this would assist the process.
