

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) (ENGLAND) ORDER 2015 (AS AMENDED)

NOTICE OF CONFIRMING A DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4(1) TO WHICH PARAGRAPHS 1(9), 1(10), 2(6) AND 2(7) OF SCHEDULE 3 APPLY

BASSETLAW DISTRICT COUNCIL (VICTORIA INSTITUTE, 2 WHARF ROAD, MISTERTON) ARTICLE 4(1) DIRECTION – 2^{ND} APRIL 2020

The Article 4(1) Direction was CONFIRMED on the 2nd April 2020, following approval from the Council's Planning Committee on the 1st April 2020.

With reference to the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015, as amended, this Direction applies to the following types of development:

- Schedule 2, Part 2 Minor Works <u>Class C – Exterior Painting</u> The painting of any part of the external brickwork or stone dressings.
- Schedule 2, Part 11 Heritage and Demolition
 <u>Class B Demolition of Buildings</u>

 Any building operation consisting of the demolition of the building coloured red on the map.

The Direction removes permitted development rights for the types of development listed above, effective from the date the Direction was confirmed (i.e. 2nd April 2020). Planning Permission is therefore required for any of the above types of development.
